SUBJECT: IDAHO POWER COMPANY: (Docket No. ADV 258/Advice No. 16-05)
Requests housekeeping tariff schedule updates to the Schedule Index and
General Rules and regulations Index resulting from recent changes to
other schedules.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) should approve Idaho Power Company's (Idaho Power or Company) housekeeping filing Advice No. 16-05 and allow it to take effect April 22, 2016.

ISSUE:

Whether the Commission should allow Idaho Power's housekeeping amendments to tariff sheets that reflect recent Commission-approved changes to other schedules.

RULES:

Under ORS 757.205(1):

Every public utility shall file with the Public Utility Commission, within a time to be fixed by the commission, schedules which shall be open to public inspection, showing all rates, tolls and charges which it has established and which are in force at the time for any service performed by it within the state, or for any service in connection therewith or performed by any public utility controlled or operated by it.

Tariff revisions or corrections may be made by filing revised sheets with the information required under the Commission's administrative rules, including OAR 860-022-0005 and OAR 860-022-0025. Filings that make any change in rates, tolls, charges, rules, or regulations must be filed with the Commission at least 30 days before the effective date of the change. ORS 757.220; OAR 860-022-0020.

ANALYSIS:

This filing contains housekeeping changes to Rule F, Schedule 40, Schedule 71, and Schedule 92 as well as page renumbering and updates to Rule G, Rule H, Schedule 23, Schedule 73, Schedule 76, Schedule 80, Schedule 82, Schedule 83, Schedule 85, Schedule 88. All of the changes either correct grammatical errors in titling or reflect updates to previous Commission-approved tariff changes. Staff did not revisit those changes in its review of this filing and no additional information requests were filed.

Staff supports the revisions filed by Idaho Power as appropriate. By their housekeeping nature, none of the revisions affect customers' rates or tariff eligibilities. Staff reviewed the proposed schedule changes to ensure that they were consistent with the rates approved by the Commission. Staff also reviewed the entire tariff file to ensure no other schedules are affected by the recent changes. Staff identified no issues or errors with the filing and recommends the Commission approve the tariff changes as filed, allowing the housekeeping revisions to go into effect.

The Company was provided a draft copy of this memo and has no concerns.

PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

Approve Idaho Power's Advice No.16-05 and allow it to go into effect April 22, 2016.
