- c) PGE is a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission. Decisions made and precedent established in this proceeding may directly affect PGE.


d) On April 25, 2016, the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (“NIPPC”) filed a petition for a temporary rulemaking, docketed as AR 598, and a request to open an investigation into PacifiCorp’s 2016 request for proposals (“RFPs”), docketed as UM 1771. PGE has a direct and substantial interest in these proceedings as any action by the Commission may affect the Renewable RFP that PGE intends to file with the Commission in Docket UM 1773. PGE will be filing comments on NIPPC’s petition that more fully describes PGE’s interest in this proceeding. No other party could adequately represent the interests of PGE.

e) PGE’s participation in this docket will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.

Accordingly, PGE petition to intervene should be granted.
