RE: Advice No. 16-14 - Idaho Power Company's Withdrawal of Schedule 85, Cogeneration and Small Power Production Standard Contract Rates

Attention Filing Center:

In compliance with ORS 757.220 and OAR 860-022-0025, Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") hereby requests authority to amend its Tariff No. E-27 to withdraw Schedule 85, Cogeneration and Small Power Production Standard Contract Rates. Additionally, this filing revises the Tariff Index to reflect the withdrawal of the schedule herein described.

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Commission") has found that avoided cost price schedules for qualifying facilities ("QFs") are not tariffs and do not fall under the statutory framework of ORS 757.210 et. seq. In Order No. 09-427, the Commission stated that ORS 757.210 "is part of the statutory framework established for the review and approval of rates *charged* by utilities for electric service...ORS 757.210 does not apply to the review and approval of rates *paid* by utilities to QFs, which is governed by the separate statutory framework set forth in ORS 758.505 to 758.555 "

Idaho Power makes this filing consistent with direction provided by the Commission. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of November 18, 2016.

The Company hereby withdraws from Tariff No. E-27:
