SUBJECT: Frontier Communications Northwest Inc., Docket No PL 53/Advice No. 046SPL, Standardizes the naming and descriptions of nonrecurring charges that were omitted in Advice 044SPL and corrects typographical errors in the Stay Seasonal Offering reconnect language.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing is effective November 20, 2016, and was filed November 10, 2016. The company proposes to standardize the naming and description of nonrecurring charges omitted in Advice 044SPL and corrects typographical errors in the Stay Seasonal Offering reconnect language in the Price List.

This filing comports with the company's revised tariff approved by the Commission in Docket No. ADV378/Advice No. 1049 effective October 31, 2016. The approved tariff change standardized both text and installation charges by renaming and restructuring nonrecurring charges.

This filing does not change the conditions of service, the terms, the rates, nor cause the withdrawal of any service.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. This filing was submitted on October 27, 2016, and thus, complies with Frontier *Price Plan*, Section Q, which requires price list changes to be filed at least one day prior to their effective dates.
