Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. (Frontier) hereby submits for electronic filing the original and a redlined copy of the revised tariff sheets for the P.U.C. OR. No, 18 Tariff.

The purpose of this filing is to remove Busy Verification and Interrupt Services from the tariff and include these services in the Statewide Price List. These services were inadvertently excluded from the services and rate elements that were moved to the Statewide Price List during the Pricing Flexibility filing submitted in Advice Letter 1041 on August 28, 2014. We have discussed these changes in advance with Commission Staff and they are not opposed.
