CenturyLink may withdraw this offer if Customer does not execute and deliver the Amendment to CenturyLink on or before November 18, 2016 ("Cutoff Date"). Using CenturyLink's electronic signature process for the Amendment is acceptable. All references to "Qwest Total Advantage" or "QTA" are replaced with "CenturyLink Total Advantage."



- **1. Term and Revenue Commitment.** As of the Amendment Effective Date, Section 2.1 of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
- **2.1 Revenue Commitment, Term.** The "Revenue Commitment" is \$0 and the new "Initial Term" is 12 months; (Code: 19012) (**Option Z**). The Initial Term begins on the Effective Date. At the end of the Initial Term, the Agreement will automatically renew on a month-to-month basis (each month a "Renewal Term") until terminated in accordance with the Agreement. The Revenue Commitment does not apply during the Renewal Term. The Term and each Renewal Term are referred to as the "Term." If during the Initial Term Customer wishes to order Service that requires a Minimum Service Period that would extend past the end of the Initial Term, the Initial Term may be extended by a mutually executed amendment to this Agreement.
- 2. Other Modifications. The Agreement is further amended as follows:
- 2.1 Domestic and International CenturyLink iQ Networking Service Exhibit
- 2.1.1 Section 1.1 Port Pricing Tables, section (a) Tiered Domestic Pricing is deleted and replaced as follows:
- 1.1 Port Pricing Tables. Pricing for Internet Ports is affected if access to the Port is over frame relay ("FR Access"). Pricing for Private Port and Enhanced Ports does not change depending on which type of access to the Port is used. Some Port types or Port speeds may not be available in all areas or with certain types of access. If Customer wishes to order domestic CenturyLink IQ Networking Service with a different bandwidth or pricing methodology than those contained in the below pricing tables, Customer must enter into a separate written amendment to this Agreement.

2.4 ISDN-PRS/DSS/UAS

- New Pricing Attachments. The following pricing attachments are added to the existing ISDN PRS, DSS, or UAS Individual Case Service Exhibit.
- Billing Information. Changes to pricing of Customer's existing Services will be effective on the third full billing cycle following the Amendment Effective Date ("Billing Change Date"). Customer will receive a credit equal to the difference between the previous MRCs and usage charges for the Domestic and International iQ Networking Service with associated Local Access Service, and their new MRCs and usage charges specified in this Amendment for the period between one month before the Amendment Effective Date and the Billing Change Date ("True-up Credit"). The True-up Credit will be applied to Customer's CenturyLink QCC charges on the first invoice following the Billing Change Date. If the True-up Credit exceeds Customer's CenturyLink QCC charges, the remainder will be applied to Customer's CenturyLink QCC charges on the following month's invoice.

4.1 This Amendment will be effective on the date the last party signs (the "Amendment Effective Date") and will become part of the Agreement. All other terms and conditions in the Agreement will remain in full force and effect and be binding upon the parties. This Amendment and the Agreement set forth the entire understanding between the parties as to the subject matter, and in the event there are any inconsistencies between the two documents, the terms of this Amendment will control.
