


SUBJECT: Asotin Telephone Company, Advice No. 126-ADV 575
Revises tariff language and rates for Intrastate Access Service
as required by FCC Order No. 11-161 and subsequent orders.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on May 22, 2017, and will go into effect on July 1, 2017.

This filing revises Asotin Telephone Company's Tariff PUC Or. No. 3, Access Services, as required by FCC Order No. 11-161, released November 18, 2011, and subsequent orders.

With this filing, Asotin also exits the NECA Traffic Sensitive Pool for Switched Access and adopts the John Staurulakis, Inc. FCC Tariff No. 1 for interstate services. Although several of the Asotin intrastate switched access rates are increasing significantly, the revenue impact is projected to be minimal as only four interexchange carriers are impacted. The estimated annual impact to carriers ranges from \$3 to \$158. Staff was provided a copy of the carrier bill message with which carriers were noticed on June 7, 2015.

As required by the FCC, intrastate access rates will more closely resemble a company's interstate access rates. This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with other schedules.
