The Public Utility Commission of Oregon will hold a Commission workshop in this docket as follows:

Commissioners will ask Idaho Power, Staff, and parties to discuss the issues raised in Staff and intervenors' recently-filed final comments. We expect the workshop to focus on the following key issues:

- Boardman to Hemingway Transmission Line (B2H):
 - Co-participant engagement
 - Costs, risks and benefits for Oregon customers
- Jim Bridger Units 1 and 2:
 - Analysis of alternative retirement dates for Jim Bridger
 - Discussions with the plant operating partner
- North Valmy Unit 1:
 - Co-owner retirement date discussions
 - Effect of closure on variable power costs

We ask Idaho Power to begin the workshop with a 15-minute overview and response to filed comments, discussing its position on these primary issues. We recognize that Idaho Power's positions may still be in development as the company's final comments are not due until February 16, 2018.

We will then ask other parties to this case to provide summary comments on the above issues. We encourage the parties to highlight their specific concerns and to respond to Idaho Power's comments and our questions, as we will have read previously-filed written comments. We will allow members of the public to provide comment as time permits.
