
RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED
PURPOSES

On March 14, 2018, Citizens Advocating for Common Sense filed a petition to intervene in this docket. Although proceedings to review a utility's integrated resource plan (IRP) are not considered contested case proceedings under ORS 183.310(2), obtaining party status is necessary to be placed on the service list to receive copies of filings made by other parties and to be eligible to sign a protective order to obtain access to protected information. For those reasons, the Commission will grant petitions to intervene in IRP dockets, even though party status does not confer the general rights and duties granted to individuals who participate in contested case proceedings.

No party objected to the petition. The petition to intervene, filed by Citizens Advocating for Common Sense is granted for the limited purposes described above.
