Attention Filing Center:

Idaho Power Company (“Idaho Power” or “Company”) transmits this filing in compliance with Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Commission”) Order No. 19-392. The Commission directed that “Starting on January 1, 2021, until the Commission determines that it will no longer accept pre-certification applications at the interim rate, utilities will file an update to the base rate by January 1st of every year.”<sup>1</sup>

Idaho Power is to include transmission, distribution, and energy charges (first 1,000 kWh) based on its Schedule 1 in setting the Residential Base Rate. This update results in a decrease of \$0.006319/kWh due to a variety of filings which became effective in 2020 on January 1, June 1, and November 1.

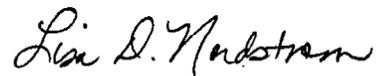
