Purpose of Workshop

This workshop is intended for Project Managers (PM), project financiers, and other Community Solar Program (CSP) stakeholders to gain a better understanding of how the PA and utilities exchange information to facilitate monthly utility bill payments. Over the past twelve months, the Program has credited nearly one-thousand utility customer accounts and began facilitating the collection and payment of PM subscription fees for CSP projects in the Portland General Electric (PGE) service territory. Soon, the PA will release new CSP platform features and functionality, including an online “payment ledger” that will display details on the status of participant billing and collections on an ongoing basis.

The PA aims for workshop attendees to understand and identify the critical program components that will allow the program to scale successfully. The PA will present on the following topics during the workshop:

- Review of the Utility monthly data exchange process for participant billing
- Payment delays, delinquencies, and non-payment
- Project Manager reporting requirements
- New Payment Ledger design and functionality
- Upcoming platform enhancements to manage subscription modifications
