RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTIONS TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On August 3, 2018, Hermiston Generating Company, L.P. filed a motion to allow Eric J. Callisto to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Mr. Callisto accompanied the motion. Mr. Callisto states that he will associate with Christopher E. Hawk, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

On August 8, 2018, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power filed a motion to allow Ajay Kumar to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Mr. Kumar accompanied the motion. Mr. Kumar states that he will associate with Matthew McVee, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that each motion complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections to either motion have been received.

The motion to admit Eric J. Callisto as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Hermiston Generating Company, L.P. is granted for a one-year period. The motion to admit Ajay Kumar as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
