**MOTION TO REINSTATE
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

***EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION
REQUESTED***

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0390(2)(b) and 860-001-0420(2), Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) hereby moves the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for an order reinstating a procedural schedule in this docket.

On September 18, 2018, PGE filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this proceeding to allow time for the parties to continue settlement discussions. ALJ Traci A. G. Kirkpatrick issued a ruling on September 19, 2018 suspending the remainder of the procedural schedule. The parties filed status reports on September 28, 2018 and October 5, 2018. The October 5, 2018 status report indicated that the parties have not been able to reach a stipulation at this time, and that a procedural motion would be filed.

PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission (“Staff”), the Citizens’ Utility Board of Oregon (“CUB”), the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (“AWEC”), Renewable Northwest, Walmart Stores, Inc. and Sam’s West Inc. (“Walmart”), Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC, and Northwest and Intermountain Power Producer Coalition (“NIPPC”) have conferred and support the procedural schedule proposed in this motion.


The parties propose that the following schedule be adopted for the remainder of this docket:
