STAFF'S MOTION TO SUSPEND
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Expedited Consideration Requested

8 Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2) and (6), Staff of the Public Utility Commission of
9 Oregon (Staff) respectfully moves Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Arlow for a ruling
10 suspending the procedural schedule in this proceeding. The Alliance of Western Energy
11 Consumers, Avangrid Renewables, Calpine Energy Solutions, Northwest and Intermountain
12 Power Producers Coalition, Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, PacifiCorp, Portland General
13 Electric, Renewable Northwest, Staff and Walmart, Inc. have engaged in settlement discussions,
14 and require additional time to determine whether settlement of some or all issues with some or
15 all parties is possible. The parties agree that they will file either a proposed schedule or a status
16 report on or before July 2, 2020. NW Energy Coalition has not been an active participant in
17 Phase II. Because Staff and Intervenor Rebuttal and Cross-Answering Testimony is due to be
18 filed on June 26, 2020, expedited consideration of this motion is requested. No party objects to
19 Staff's Motion.
