RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO SUSPEND SCHEDULE GRANTED

On September 18, 2018, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in the above-captioned docket. As reply and cross-answering testimony is due by the close of business today, PGE requests expedited treatment of the motion. PGE indicates that productive settlement discussions have been occurring, and seeks suspension of the procedural schedule to allow time for these discussions to continue and for the potential preparation and execution of a stipulation. PGE anticipates that the parties will be able to file either a stipulation or an update by September 28, 2018. PGE represents that the following parties support the motion: Commission Staff; the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board; the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers; Renewable Northwest; Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC; the Northwest and Intermountain Power Produce Coalition; and Walmart Stores, Inc. and Sam's West Inc.

I grant PGE's motion on an expedited basis, and suspend the procedural schedule. In the event that a stipulation is not previously filed, I direct Commission Staff or PGE to file a status report by the close of business on September 28, 2018.
