RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On February 25, 2020, a telephone prehearing conference was held in the docket and a mutually agreed upon procedural schedule was adopted by the Commission. The schedule provided that Staff and Intervenors' cross-answering testimony was due no later than June 12, 2020.

On June 11, 2020, Staff filed a Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule, asking that the date for the submission of Staff's and Intervenors' rebuttal and cross-answering testimony be extended to June 26, 2020. Staff has requested expedited consideration of its motion.

In support of its motion, Staff states that Avangrid Renewables, Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, PacifiCorp, Renewable Northwest, and Walmart, Inc., support Staff's motion and that Calpine Energy Solutions, Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, and Portland General Electric do not oppose Staff's motion. Staff further states that NW Energy Coalition reviewed the motion and did not have concerns.

In light of the support of a number of intervenors also affected by the current schedule deadline, and the absence of opposition to Staff's motion by PGE and other intervenors, I find that there is good cause shown to modify the schedule.

RULING

The Commission Staff's Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule is granted. Staff's and Intervenors' rebuttal and cross-answering testimony shall be filed no later than June 26, 2020. The remainder of the procedural schedule is unchanged.
