RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On August 13, 2019, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. PGE states that based on Staff's and other parties' testimony filed on July 29, 2019, it appears that some issues can be resolved through settlement discussions. PGE is requesting that the schedule be suspended to allow time for the parties to hold settlement discussions, and if the discussions are successful, submit a stipulation resolving some issues. PGE plans on filing a status report or request a prehearing conference within a week after the first settlement conference.

PGE requests expedited treatment of its motion. PGE discussed the suspension of the schedule with the other parties and asserts that all of the parties either support the motion or do not object.

For good cause shown, PGE's motion is granted and the procedural schedule is suspended. The parties are directed to file a status report or schedule a prehearing conference by September 16, 2019.
