
DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On June 1, 2018, Renewable Northwest (Renewable NW) filed a motion to allow Mr. Maxwell Greene to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Mr. Greene accompanied the motion. Mr. Greene states that he will associate with Ms. Sylvia Tanner, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No timely objections have been received.

The motion to admit Mr. Maxwell Green as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Renewable NW is granted for a one-year period. Should the case extend past one year, Mr. Greene must file a new application to continue to participate in the case on a *pro hac vice* basis.
