MEMORANDUM

On April 9, 2019, Portland General Electric Company filed a proposed schedule for Phase II as directed by Order No. 19-075. To date, none of the parties have filed an objection or comments. I intend to adopt the proposed schedule with certain modifications. The hearing date would be moved to October 24, 2019, a Thursday, to better accommodate the Commissioners' schedules. Also, a due date for cross-examination statements and cross-examination exhibits of October 11, 2019 would be added.

I would like to provide the opportunity for parties to respond to PGE's request. If any party objects to the proposed schedule or my proposed modifications, that party should do so by May 13, 2019. If no objections are received, I shall issue a ruling adopting the proposed schedule with the modifications. Parties may also request a prehearing conference if there is a need to discuss the schedule further.
