MEMORANDUM AND RULING

**DISPOSITION: PARTIES TO PROVIDE INFORMATION IN ADVANCE OF ORAL
ARGUMENT**

On October 16, 2020, I issued a ruling revising the procedural schedule. In that ruling, I noted that oral argument in this docket will be held on December 3, 2020, and that each of the parties presenting at oral argument will be required to file statements by November 13, 2020, setting forth the issues that each intends to argue and the amount of time requested for each issue. Each party shall also include a statement as to whether they plan to discuss any confidential or highly confidential information, as separate arrangements must be made for those discussions at the oral argument.

The parties are hereby notified that oral argument will be conducted via the Zoom Webinar format. In order to properly utilize this format, all parties to the proceeding must advise the Commission whether they intend to participate in oral argument, and those parties choosing to participate in oral argument before the Commission shall provide the following information on or before November 6, 2020:

1. The name of the counsel who will be speaking on behalf of the party.
2. Counsel's contact information (email address and telephone number).
3. We will use video for the mode of participation and, if a counsel has a need that would necessitate telephone participation, please email Cheryl Walker at cheryl.walker@puc.state.or.us.

Upon receipt of this information, the Administrative Hearings Division will contact the participating counsel and arrange for Zoom Webinar practice and tutorial sessions, as may be necessary, in seeking to assure that the oral argument is conducted in a clear, orderly, and efficient manner.

Please note that the Commissioners will be attending the oral argument, and the parties should be prepared to address questions from the Commissioners during their presentations. No screen sharing functions or power point presentations will be used.
