MEMORANDUM

Investigation into Proposed Green Tariff

On August 14, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge granted Portland General Electric Company's motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this proceeding to allow time for settlement discussions. On September 6, 2019, PGE indicated that the parties had not reached a settlement, and requested a prehearing conference to establish a schedule for the remainder of this proceeding.

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon will conduct a prehearing conference in these proceedings on October 3, 2019. In advance of the prehearing conference, I request that the parties confer and jointly propose a procedural schedule to the extent possible by September 26, 2019. For any procedural milestones upon which the parties fail to agree, I request that the parties submit individual proposals by September 26, 2019. In preparing proposed schedules for discussion at the prehearing conference, I request that parties include the opportunity for oral argument, in addition to the traditional milestones.

Please note that any evidentiary hearing and oral argument should be scheduled on Tuesday afternoons or Thursday mornings or afternoons.
