RULING

DISPOSITION: PHASE II PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED.

At the October 22, 2019 Regular Public Meeting, on its own motion, the Commission voted to open a process to review and potentially amend Order No. 19-075, regarding Phase I of this proceeding, consistent with ORS 756.568. Additionally, the Commission voted to suspend Phase II of this proceeding pending the Phase I clarification process. As a result, the procedural schedule for Phase II, as adopted on October 8, 2019 is suspended.

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon will conduct a prehearing conference to establish a procedural schedule for review and potential amendment of Order No. 19-075 in the near term. In advance of scheduling the prehearing conference, I request that the parties confer and jointly propose a procedural schedule to the extent possible by Tuesday, November 12, 2019. To the extent that parties fail to agree, I request that the parties submit individual proposals by Tuesday, November 12, 2019.

Please note that any Commission-involved events should be scheduled on Tuesday afternoons, or Thursday mornings or afternoons.
