To Whom it May Concern,

The City of Milwaukie is delighted to have signed a 15-year commitment to Green Future Impact, the green tariff product offered by Portland General Electric. The city is appreciative for the support that the Oregon Public Utility Commission provided to PGE through development of Green Future Impact.

In October of 2018, the City of Milwaukie adopted the Milwaukie Community Climate Action Plan, a strategy of 53 city-led actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and achieve carbon neutrality community-wide by 2050. Through the Climate Action Plan, Milwaukie identified a key mitigation strategy of working with PGE to reach net-zero carbon emissions from all electricity by 2035. The Green Future Impact product provides us an opportunity to decarbonize our city’s operational electricity with 100% renewable energy. We are proud that the city can lead by example with Green Future Impact, and we look forward to continuing our work with PGE to shift Milwaukie’s residents and business to carbon-free energy sources in order to meet our overall goal of community-wide carbon-free electricity.
