SUBJECT: FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS NORTHWEST INC:
(Docket No. PL 94/Advice No. 054SPL) Removes references to Busy Verification and Busy Interrupt services from the Statewide Price List.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. This filing removes references to the abandoned Busy Verification and Busy Interrupt services from the company's Statewide Price List in compliance with Order No. 18-182 in Docket No. UM 1935. The filing was submitted on May 24, 2018, and went into effect on June 1, 2018.

Applicable Rule or Law

On February 27, 2018, Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. (Frontier) and Citizens Telecommunications Company of Oregon (Citizens) filed a joint petition to abandon their respective Busy Verification and Busy Interrupt service offerings pursuant to OAR 860-032-0020. The Commission issued its Order No. 18-182 granting the petition on May 23, 2018. The order directs Frontier and Citizens to make the necessary tariff and price list filings to designate the services as abandoned.

Analysis

In compliance with Order No. 18-182, this filing removes references to Busy Verification and Busy Interrupt services from Frontier's Statewide Price List. The filing does not affect the rates, terms, or conditions of service for any other services.

Conclusion

This filing complies with all applicable laws and Commission orders. The filing has already gone into effect, and an acknowledgement letter should be sent. No further action is necessary.
