J. In deciding on the reasonableness of a particular agreement, the Company will take into account the customer's ability to pay, the size of the unpaid balance; the customer's payment history and length of service, and the amount of time and reasons why the debt is outstanding.

- L. Late Payment Charge (OAR 860-21-126)
  - 1. A late payment charge will apply to accounts not paid in full each month and leaving an unpaid balance of \$30.00 or more to be carried forward.
  - 2. The late payment charge will be listed separately and included in the total amount due on the current bill.
  - 3. The minimum late charge is \$0.50.
  - 4. The rates of interest paid will be established annually by the Oregon Public Utility Commission, in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-21-126.
  - 5. In accordance with OAR 860-21-126(3) and OAR 860-34-120(2), the applicable monthly interest rate will be established annually by the Oregon Public Utility Commission.
- The residence Returned Payment Charge increase is delayed and will increase from \$20.00 to \$30.00, effective May 1, 2019.
