RE: Withdrawing Advice No. 19-05, NEW Schedule 150 Transportation Electrification Cost Recovery Mechanism

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) hereby withdraws its Schedule 150 that PGE filed February 15, 2019 (Advice 19-05) to establish a cost recovery rate schedule (automatic adjustment clause) for the amortization of incremental costs associated with its transportation electrification (TE) pilots not otherwise included in rates. PGE is withdrawing its filing based on a revised stipulation reached in Docket No. UM 1811 in which PGE agrees not to seek cost recovery for capital related costs associated with the three TE pilots (TriMet, education and outreach, and electric avenues) until its next general rate case. This then obviates the need for Schedule 150 which would have tracked in such capital. The revised stipulation is in the process of having signatures collected and is expected to be filed for Commission consideration within the next week. Given that Docket No. UE 360 was opened to investigate Schedule 150, we understand that withdrawing Schedule 150 likely means closing the UE 360 docket investigation.
