RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On November 19, 2021, Brookfield Renewable Trading and Marketing LP filed a motion to allow Laura K. Granier and Austin W. Jensen to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The certificates of compliance of Ms. Granier and Mr. Jensen accompanied the motion. Ms. Granier and Mr. Jensen state that they will associate with Hayley K. Siltanen, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Laura K. Granier and Austin W. Jensen as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Brookfield Renewable Trading and Marketing LP is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
