Renewable Northwest is a non-profit advocacy organization that works to facilitate the expansion of responsibly developed renewable resources in the Northwest. Renewable Northwest has 58 member organizations that include renewable energy developers and manufacturers, as well as consumer advocates, environmental groups, academic institutions, and other industry advisers. The common goal of Renewable Northwest's members is to promote the development of a cost-effective, reliable, and clean energy system for the betterment of the Northwest economy and environment.

4. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

In pursuit of our mission to advocate for the expansion of cost-effective and environmentally responsible renewable energy in the Northwest, we actively participate in proceedings and discussions related to utility resource planning and procurement processes. Renewable Northwest has been an active stakeholder in both Portland General Electric's and PacifiCorp's 2019 Integrated Resource Plans ("IRP"). Additionally, Renewable Northwest's members include both environmental advocates, at least one of whom served on Idaho Power's IRP Advisory Council, and developers of renewable resources who may be indirectly interested in Idaho Power's proposal to increase its ties to Northwest power markets via new transmission. Accordingly, no other party can adequately represent Renewable Northwest's interest in this proceeding.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:

Renewable Northwest intends to participate as a party and raise issues that are appropriate to the proceeding.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:

Renewable Northwest has a long history of participating in discussions and regulatory proceedings related to utility resource planning and procurement. For example, we have participated and continue to participate in LC 70 and in the

informal process leading to PacifiCorp's 2019 IRP, and LC 73 and the informal process around Portland General Electric's 2019 IRP.
