Additionally, the Commission will conduct a Public Comment Hearing in Ontario, on April 23, 2020. For the Special Public Meeting following Staff and Intervenor final comments, the Commission will investigate options for facilitating remote participation from eastern Oregon, and requests that parties provide potential options.

Please note that the Commission Workshop and any Special Public Meetings in Salem should be scheduled on Tuesday afternoons or Thursday mornings or afternoons.

This proceeding is not a contested case under ORS 183.310(2) and will be conducted under the process set forth in OAR 860-027-0400. Persons need not intervene as a party in order to participate in this proceeding, and may attend workshops, submit written comments, and provide oral comments to the Commission at public comment meetings. Persons may seek party status, however, for the limited purpose of obtaining access to confidential information pursuant to the terms of a protective order. The Commission strongly encourages any person seeking party status in these proceedings for that purpose to file a petition to intervene before the prehearing conference. *See* OAR 860-001-0300. Petitions to intervene received before the prehearing conference may be ruled upon during the conference. Party status in this proceeding, however, does not confer the general rights and duties as those of parties in contested case proceedings. A form petition to intervene can be found online at:
