RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On October 28, 2021, Idaho Power Company filed a motion to allow Donovan E. Walker to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in the docket identified above. An affidavit of Mr. Walker and a certificate of good standing from the Idaho State Bar accompanied the motion. Mr. Walker indicated in the affidavit that he will associate with Adam Lowney, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No timely objections to the motion were received.

The motion to admit Donovan E. Walker as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power is granted for a one-year period. For cases lasting more than one year, a new application to continue appearing *pro hac vice* must be filed.
