RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On October 26, 2023, Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) filed a motion to allow Megan Goicoechea Allen to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. A signed statement of Megan Goicoechea Allen accompanied the motion. Megan Goicoechea Allen states that she will associate with Adam Lowney, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Megan Goicoechea Allen as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
