RULING

DISPOSITION: EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED ON EXPEDITED BASIS

On May 23, 2022, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion to extend the due date for filing prehearing briefs by one week, to May 31, 2022. As prehearing briefs are currently due on May 24, 2022, Staff requests expedited treatment. Staff represents that a one-week extension will not interfere with subsequent events on the existing procedural schedule. Staff indicates that all parties were contacted and that no party opposes Staff's motion.

Given the imminent deadline for prehearing briefs and Staff's representation that all parties have been contacted and do not oppose the motion, I grant Staff's motion on an expedited basis. All parties are directed to file prehearing briefs by 3:00 p.m. on May 31, 2022. No other changes to the procedural schedule are necessary.
