RULING

Pursuant to ORS 756.500.

DISPOSITION: JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND TIME GRANTED

By ruling of February 4, 2021, I granted St. Louis Solar, LLC motion for leave to file second amended complaint, and instructed Portland General Electric Company to file its response on or before February 24, 2021. On February 18, 2021, St. Louis Solar subsequently filed a clean version of its second amended Complaint.

On February 19, 2021, St. Louis Solar and PGE filed a Joint Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule and requested expedited consideration. In the motion, the parties ask that the deadline for PGE to file its response to the second amended complaint be moved from February 24, 2021, to March 24, 2021. Also, the parties state that the extension of time will allow the parties time to pursue settlement discussions.

RULING

I find that granting the Joint Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record. The motion is granted. Portland General Electric Company shall file its response to the second amended complaint on or before March 24, 2021.
