Hello, UM 2057 Parties. On behalf of ALJ Arlow, I am sending this email to follow-up after the telephone prehearing conference this morning and to clarify the next step for the parties, as follows:

The time cycle on pending pleadings is being held in abeyance for a week. Parties should submit a letter by COB today indicating:

1. The name of any responsive pleading they intend to file
2. Such pleading's current due date
3. Whether the pleading will need to be accompanied by a motion or request for waiver to be submitted
4. The pleading's due date if all pending pleadings are held in abeyance for a week.

It is preferred, if possible, for the parties to file a joint letter, or that a filing party can make a representation of mutual understanding.
