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

**JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Expedited Consideration Requested

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420, Complainant Zena Solar, LLC (“Zena Solar”) and Defendant Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) respectfully request that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Commission”) issue an order modifying the procedural schedule in this case by extending procedural deadlines as detailed below. The purpose of this extension is to provide the parties additional time to discuss settlement.

The requested changes to the schedule are as follows:

Selection of Procedural Path	July 27, 2020	August 10, 2020
PGE Response to Zena Solar Motion for Interim Relief & Preliminary Injunction	August 7, 2020 (dependent on Procedural Path selected)	August 21, 2020
Interim Relief Period Deadline	September 8, 2020	September 22, 2020

The “Selection of Procedural Path” event is when the parties decide which procedural path to pursue. The default is Path 1, which involves resolution of Zena Solar’s motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction (“PI Motion”) before resolution of the merits of the case. Path 2 involves the consolidated and expedited resolution of both the merits of the case and the PI Motion. The parties will pursue Path 1 unless they agree in writing by August 10, 2020, to pursue Path 2.

If the procedural schedule proposed above is approved, the parties agree the dates in the procedural paths need to change as follows:
