To the Public Utility Commission of Oregon:

Thank you for guiding the implementation of the Oregon Community Solar Program (the “CSP”). Fruitland Creek Solar, LLC is developing a single 1.75 MW project in the service territory of the Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) and is looking forward to continuing to see this project, and the CSP, advance.

Fruitland Creek Solar understands that PGE has proposed a tariff that would change the allocation of CSP costs across PGE’s customer base. Fruitland Creek Solar believes that the CSP furthers decarbonization of energy supply in Oregon and provides a public benefit and a public good that benefits all customers. Fruitland Creek Solar does not take a position on PGE’s proposed tariff, but does support the Commission and PGE considering responsibility of program costs.
