NOTICE OF DISMISSAL WITH
PREJUDICE

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0000 and Oregon Rule of Civil Procedure (“ORCP”) 54 A(1), Carnes Creek Solar, LLC (“Carnes Creek Solar”) hereby files this voluntary Notice of Dismissal With Prejudice as to all claims in this proceeding against defendant Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”). Carnes Creek Solar has consulted PGE, and PGE does not oppose dismissal with prejudice. Carnes Creek Solar respectfully requests that the Commission close the docket.

Carnes Creek Solar intends to file an interconnection complaint, which includes requests for the Oregon Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) to make findings regarding PGE’s discrimination, unreasonable treatment and other actions against Carnes Creek Solar related to interconnection issues.¹ Carnes Creek Solar understands that the dismissal of this complaint with prejudice will not limit its ability to raise claims unrelated to this complaint,
