

NOTICE: UM 2099 SCOPE AND SCHEDULE

On May 21, 2020, PGE filed a request to modify its Agreement for Net Metering and Interconnection Services.

Staff facilitated a kick-off workshop on July 13, 2020. Participants discussed the scope of this docket and the appropriate schedule to bring PGE's request to a Regular Public Meeting.

Following the workshop discussion, Staff finalized the following scope and schedule for UM 2099:

Scope

PGE's request to modify its net metering agreement raises two questions:

1. Has PGE proposed an appropriate interim solution for the system constraint issues facing a subset of prospective net metering customers; and
2. What are the appropriate long-term solutions for the underlying interconnection policy and distribution system planning and operations issues?

Staff finds that the UM 2099 investigation—including the workshops and opportunities for comment—should focus on the approval of PGE's filing as an interim solution to immediate system constraints. Staff finds that other venues, such as distribution system planning (UM 2005) and the general investigation into interconnection process and policies (UM 2111), are better suited for discussion of long-term solutions to the underlying issues.

Schedule

Staff has identified the following schedule to facilitate the review of PGE's UM 2099 proposal:

August 3, 2020	Technical workshop
August 21, 2020	Staff and Stakeholder comments
September 22, 2020	PGE reply comments
September 30, 2020	Follow-up workshop [if needed]
October 29, 2020	Staff recommendation memo
November 3, 2020	Commission decision at Regular Public Meeting
