Dear Ms. Menza and ALJ Kirkpatrick,

Sunthurst and PacifiCorp are attempting to work out a mutually acceptable solution to for treatment of portions of PacifiCorp's response to Sunthurst Data Request 13.4 which may contain Confidential Information. Resolution of this issue will affect Sunthurst's list of Supplemental Exhibits.

The parties were not able to resolve the matter today and therefore Sunthurst moves to postpone the parties' deadline for filing their list of Exhibits and Supplemental Exhibits to Thursday, March 11.

Sunthurst also requests a brief pre-hearing conference with ALJ Kirkpatrick on Wednesday afternoon (between 2-4pm) or Thursday morning (between 8-11 am), which the parties will cancel in the event they work out a solution prior to the conference.
