RULING

DISPOSITION: PARTIES DIRECTED TO MAKE ALL LEGAL ARGUMENTS IN BRIEFS; DEADLINE TO FILE REPLY BRIEFS EXTENDED TO APRIL 13, 2021

Simultaneous reply briefs are due in this docket on April 9, 2021, and oral arguments are scheduled for April 13, 2021. In consultation with the Commissioners, and pursuant to OAR 860-001-0650, I direct parties to make all legal arguments in briefs.¹ Given the factual nature of the issues in these proceedings, legal argument is best developed in context of, and with the application of the facts, which is best done in briefs rather than during oral argument. To allow additional time for thorough development of legal argument in closing briefs, the due date is extended to the close of business on April 13, 2021. Official notice of the cancellation of oral argument will be separately issued.
