RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On February 18, 2021, Fred Meyer Stores, Inc. a subsidiary of The Kroger Co. and Quality Food Centers, a Division of the Fred Meyer Stores, Inc. (Fred Meyer), filed a motion to allow Kurt J. Boehm and Jody Kyler Cohn to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavits of Mr. Boehm and Ms. Cohn accompanied the motion. Mr. Boehm and Ms. Cohn each state that they will associate with Peter Vaughan Shaver, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that they comply with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Kurt J. Boehm and Jody Kyler Cohn as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Fred Meyer is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
