MEMORANDUM REGARDING  
REMOTE HEARING

The evidentiary hearing in this proceeding will begin at 1:30 p.m. on October 11, 2021. We will launch the Zoom meeting at 1:15 p.m. to provide time for everyone to join the meeting and test audio, video, and screen-sharing.

We will record the hearing and a transcriptionist will produce an official transcript of the proceeding. Any other recording of the hearing, either video or audio, is prohibited. The official transcript will be available from the transcriptionist.

Due to the limited time reserved for hearings, any procedural matters should be raised in advance of the hearing in writing so there are no delays to the start of testimony. The purpose of this hearing is cross examination of the witnesses. For each witness, counsel will have the opportunity for a brief direct examination to have witness adopt any pre-filed testimony and exhibits, and make any corrections before we move to cross examination.
