4. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

In pursuit of our mission to advocate for the expansion of cost-effective and environmentally responsible renewable energy in the Northwest, we actively participate in proceedings and discussions related to utility resource planning and procurement processes. Renewable Northwest has been an active stakeholder in Portland General Electric's, PacifiCorp's, and Idaho Power's 2019 Integrated Resource Plans ("IRP"), as well as PacifiCorp's 2020 All-Source Request for Proposals (Commission Docket No. UM 2059) and many utility planning and solicitation processes in other states. Renewable Northwest also participated in the rulemaking that led to adoption of the Commission's current Division 089 rules that will govern this proceeding. Accordingly, no other party can adequately represent Renewable Northwest's interest in this proceeding.
