DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED

**PURPOSES** 

The Commission has received petitions to intervene in this docket from the Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC), the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers' (AWEC), and Capital Power Corporation.

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2). Nonetheless, obtaining party status is necessary for purposes of being on the eDockets "service list" and is necessary for eligibility to sign the General Protective Order No. 21-161. For those reasons, the Commission will grant the petitions to intervene, even though party status does not confer the general rights and duties to individuals who participate in contested case proceedings.

The petitions to intervene filed by NIPPC, AWEC, and Capital Power is granted for the limited purposes described above.
