NOTICE

2021 All-Source Request for Proposals

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits the following notice to meet the requirements of the Commission's December 2nd, 2021 Request for Proposals (RFP) Approval Order.¹

PGE will not make Colstrip Transmission System (CTS) transmission rights or any other PGE controlled Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) transmission rights available for bidders to satisfy bidder's transmission eligibility requirements.

Within its RFP evaluation, PGE will consider multiple Colstrip retirement scenarios to evaluate how the long-term availability of CTS rights could lower total costs for PGE customers. PGE will specifically consider the CTS transmission availability impacts associated with the retirement or divestment of Colstrip Unit 3 and/or Unit 4 in 2026 – which is aligned with PGE's proposed Colstrip depreciation schedule – and 2030 per the requirements of Oregon Senate Bill 1547. All bids who could utilize CTS transmission rights will be evaluated with and without the application of PGE's CTS rights. PGE's final shortlist risk assessment will include evaluations of how customer costs and risks are impacted by the uncertainty associated with CTS transmission availability.
