**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF  
AFFILIATE BID**

At its December 14, 2021 public meeting for Docket No. UI 461, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) rejected without prejudice Portland General Electric Company’s (PGE) application to modify its Master Service Agreement to provide support services, priced at the higher of fully allocated cost or market, to PGE’s affiliate, Portland Renewable Resource Company, LLC (PRR). However, the Commission invited PGE to re-file the application with modifications, including controls to enhance customer protections.

On December 17, 2021, PGE filed a Notice of Intent to Submit Bid stating its intent to submit an affiliate bid into the 2021 All-Source Request for Proposals (RFP) by the deadline for affiliate and benchmark bids of January 4, 2022. On January 4, 2022, PRR submitted an affiliate bid into the RFP. The affiliate bid was conditioned upon approval by the Commission of a revised application to modify PGE’s Master Service Agreement to provide support services to PRR. The affiliate bid would be withdrawn if the Commission did not approve the application or if agreement had yet to be reached with Staff and stakeholders on the appropriate controls.

Since then, PGE has continued to engage with stakeholders to address concerns with the initial affiliate application, particularly with respect to substantive controls to ensure appropriate customer protections as well as to respond to comments from Commissioners during the December 14, 2021 public meeting. PGE is committed to continuing conversations with stakeholders and wants to create the time needed for this collaborative work to occur.

Therefore, earlier today, PRR notified the Independent Evaluator that it has withdrawn the affiliate bid from PGE’s RFP.

It is expected that PGE will file an application to modify its Master Services Agreement to provide support services to PRR, with substantive customer protections, in the future providing sufficient time to obtain Commission approval and begin the development of affiliate bids in support of fulfilling future PGE procurement needs.
