SUBJECT: **Canby Telephone Association, Docket No ADV 1270/Advice Letter No. 22
Revises tariff PUC Or. No. 3 Access Services as required by FCC Order No.
11-161 and subsequent orders.**

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on May 24, 2021 and will go into effect on July 1, 2021.

This filing revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No 3, Access Services, as required by FCC Order No. 20-143; Part 51 – Interconnection; Subpart M – 8YY Transition; §51.909 Transition of rate-of-return carrier access charges; Step 2.

This filing includes tariff revisions for the following seven (7) companies:

- Canby Telephone Association
- Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company
- Eagle Telephone System, Inc.
- Molalla Communications Company
- Mt. Angel Telephone Company
- Nehalem Telecommunications, Inc.
- Scio Mutual Telephone Association

The FCC Order establishes separate rate elements for interstate and intrastate toll free originating end office access service and non-toll free originating end office access service. Intrastate toll free originating end office access service rates shall be in parity with its interstate toll free originating end office access service rates. Currently each of the Company's intrastate originating access service rates are greater than interstate rates. Therefore, in this filing the companies propose rate reductions to bring the composite rate levels into parity.

Other than noted above, this filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with other schedules. This filing is revenue neutral for these Companies.

It is requested that this filing become effective July 1, 2021.
