SCHEDULING MEMORANDUM

To ensure adequate time to address the remaining issues at oral argument, and in light of the bench requests issued today, the Commission intends to add a second oral argument to the procedural schedule. The agenda for the second oral argument date will be dedicated to issues related to vegetation management, wildfire mitigation, and the provision in the third partial stipulation terminating Portland General Electric Company's decoupling mechanism.<sup>1</sup> Any other issues will be addressed at the March 4, 2022 oral argument, under the original schedule.
