RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On October 27, 2021, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB) filed a motion seeking to modify the procedural schedule. CUB explains that due to a conflict that has arisen, CUB is now unavailable for a week during the briefing period. CUB requests to move the deadline for closing briefs from February 28, 2022, to March 2, 2022 (or, in the alternative, March 1, 2022). CUB states that it contacted counsel for all parties in this proceeding and that no party opposes this motion. CUB indicates that the proposed deadline for closing briefs represents a compromise after consultation with the other parties.

I find good cause to grant CUB's motion and modify the deadline for closing briefs to March 2, 2022. The procedural schedule is modified as set forth below.
