MEMORANDUM REGARDING
MARCH 17, 2022 ORAL ARGUMENT

The Commission will conduct an oral argument in this proceeding on March 17, 2022 on issues related to wildfire mitigation, vegetation management, and decoupling. The below agenda identifies the parties that will be participating in the order in which they will be presenting. I anticipate taking a 10 minute recess after concluding with the wildfire mitigation and vegetation management issues, and before starting with the decoupling portion of the agenda.

Please note that the Commissioners will attend the oral argument, and the time allotted includes the time to address any questions from the Commissioners. Parties should be prepared to address questions from the Commissioners and should anticipate questions starting within the first few minutes of their presentations. Additionally, while parties may use screen sharing to the extent necessary to show an exhibit for illustrative purposes, the use of power point presentation is strongly discouraged.
